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Treviso and the Garden of Venice is a project that comprises 16 companies gathered together in a Temporary Business Association (ATI) operating throughout the province of Treviso and co-financed by the POR 2014-2020 (hereinafter POC - Complementary Operational Program - born from the reprogramming the POR FESR-FSE 2014-2020, in order to answer the health, economic and social problems caused by COVID-19 health emergency).

The main objective is to promote the tourist offer of the Treviso area thanks to the support and the coordinating role of the OGD Città d'Arte and Ville Venete del Territorio Trevigiano.

Outdoor activities such as cycling tourism, horse trails,

trekking and authentic food and wine and culture of the territory, are the main focus of the promotion.

The major themes of the experiences are: Gravel in the Land of Venice, Monaco-Venice Cycle Route and the biking routes that branch off from Treviso and its province in a "daisy" format, such as: the Treviso Ostiglia, the GreenWay along the Sile River, the Gira Monticano and the Gira Livenza, the Cycling Rings in the area of the Conegliano Valdobbiadene Hills, UNESCO World Heritage and the Asolano and Montegrappa's routes (MAB Reserve, Man and Biosphere recently recognized by UNESCO).

in Vittorio Veneto, Asolo with
its characters and its
hills. Marca Trevigiana is
also attractive for its culi-
nary culture and its wine tou-
rism with the Spring of Pro-
secco, the Tiramisù and the
Spiedo dell'Altamarca, a must
tasted speciality.

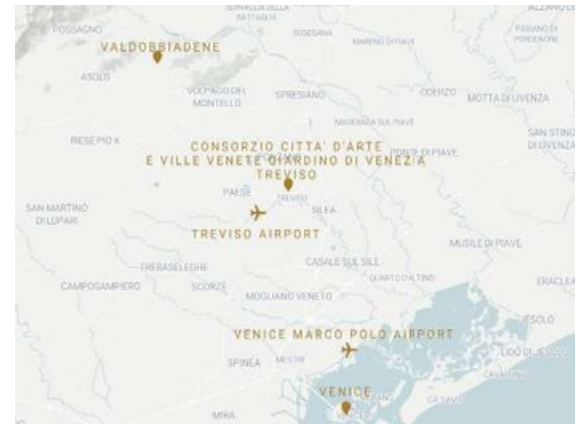
TREVISO

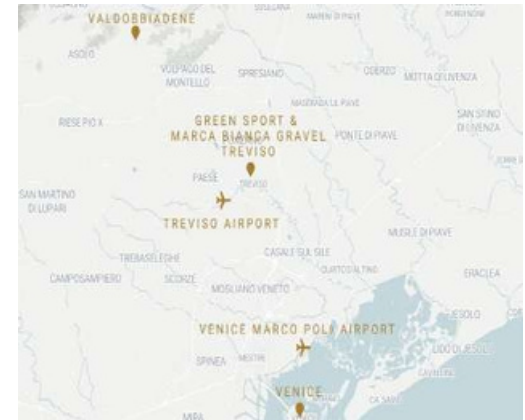




Gravel Marca Tour & Marca Bianca

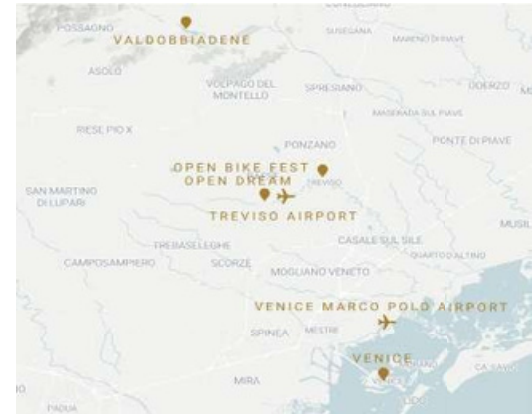




Interzeta

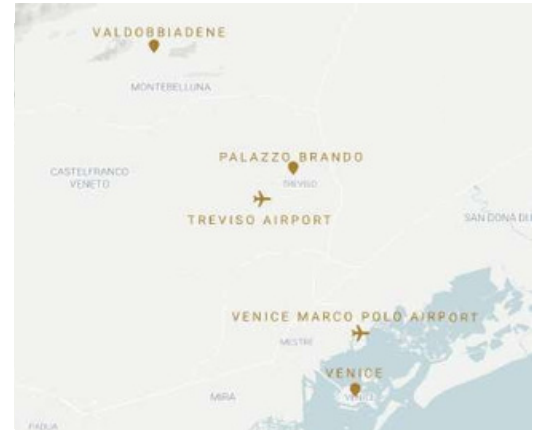




Palazzo Brando

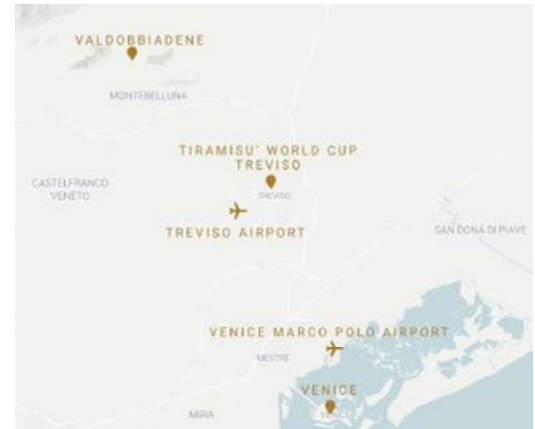

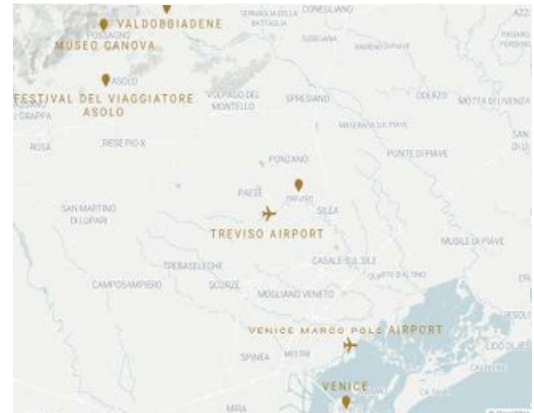

CASTELFRANCO VENETO

The heart of Castelfranco Veneto is enclosed by a fascinating wall, one of the best and longest preserved in Italy. Walking through the streets picturesque places and prestigious buildings can be seen, such as the Teatro Accademico and the Palazzo del Monte di Pietà, a source of loans for the poor of the city and surrounding villages up to the 1900s. Castelfranco Veneto is known for being the birthplace of Giorgione, most extraordinary and enigmatic artist of the fifteenth century. His most celebrated work is the Altarpiece of Castelfranco that can be admired in the Duomo of S. Maria Assunta.

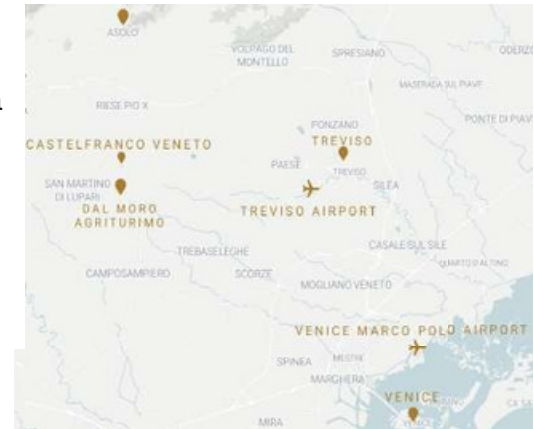

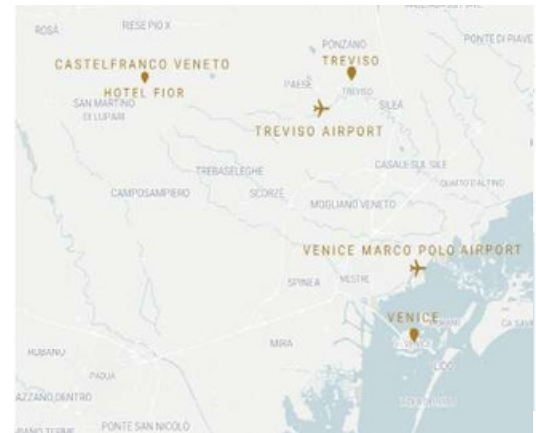


Hotel Fior

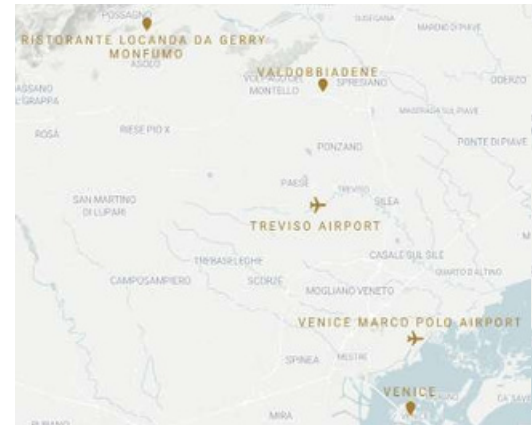

VALDOBBIADENE

Valdobbiadene is a renaissance town that enjoys the fresh breeze descending from the Dolomites. Together with Conegliano and its Prosecco Hills, it has become a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2019. Here, away from the limelight, the world-renowned Prosecco wine is produced, including its most precious and rare variety which goes under the name of "Cartizze".

Beautiful hill ridges, medieval villages and hamlets, forests and cultivations surround the city centre, resulting in a distinctive chequered landscape characterised by rows of vines parallel and vertical to the slope.

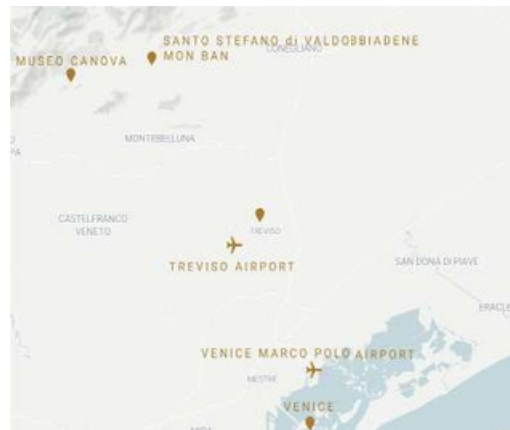

The castle today serves as a truly distinctive, unique venue for memory-worthy events.

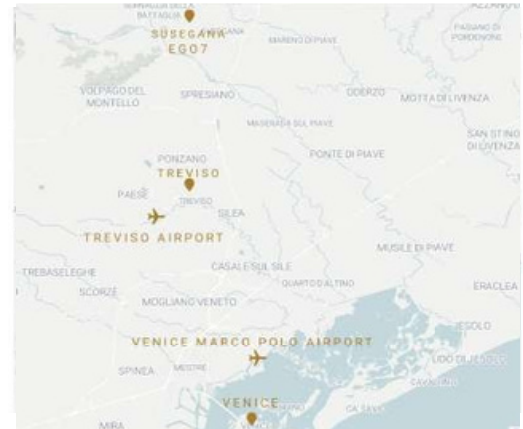
The Collalto Estate is another icon in Susegana with its castle ruins and the magnificent Borgo Luce, a winery, an agritourism and a shop of fine local products.

VITTORIO VENETO

Vittorio Veneto stands on the slopes of the hills of Treviso and cut through by the calm waters of the Meschio River where a three mile pedestrian path offers unprecedented views of Vittorio Veneto, through old buildings, old mills and the characteristic "Meschet", hydraulic works made by the Serravallesi to hold the river after the disastrous flood of 1598. The city was founded by the merging of the two towns of Ceneda and Serravalle. Vittorio Veneto, known for its battle, that marked the end of the Great World War, is also known for its music tradition.

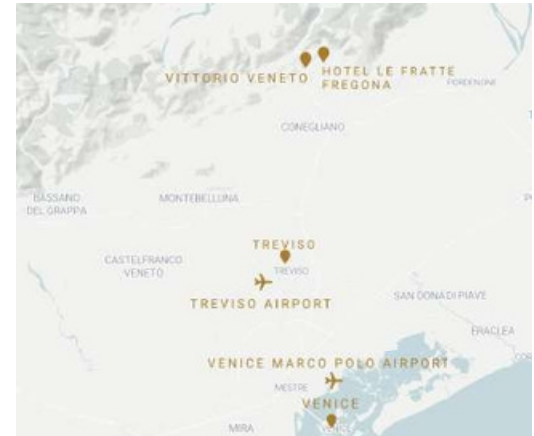

CANSIGLIO

The Cansiglio is a pre-Alpine plateau between the provinces of Belluno, Treviso and Pordenone. With the characteristic shape of its karstic basin, it's a true hiking paradise for its forest, which is the second largest in Italy.

In this territory there is an ethnic Cimbrian settlement dating back to the early 1800s. Currently the villages of Campon and Pian Osteria are inhabited by the Cimbri. The Ethnographic and Cimbrian Cultural Museum, an historic building in Pian Osteria, showcases the woodworking and craft activities of the Cimbri, as well as their culture and legends.

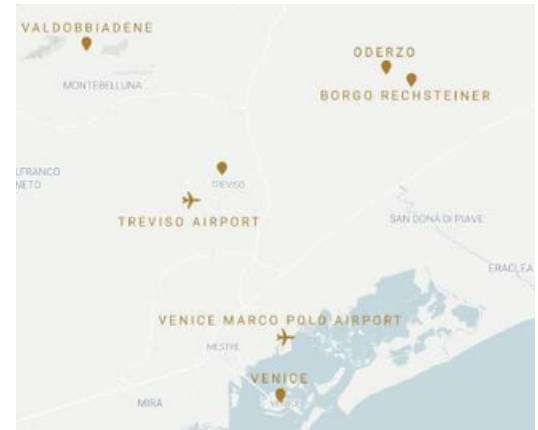

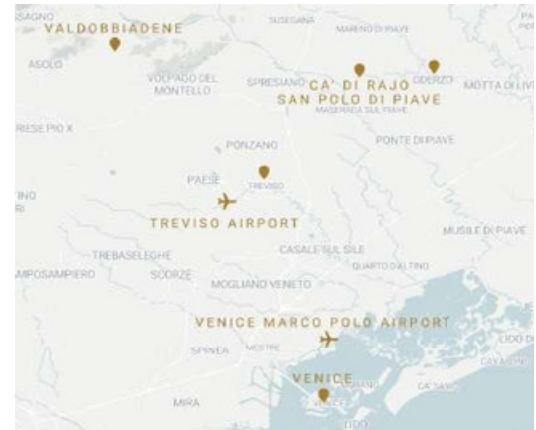




Ca' di Rajo
